

- A random sample of 1200 persons, representing the Turkish population on and over the age of 18, were faceto-face interviewed in their private residences.











European states have promoted and protected ethnic separatist movements in Turkey


European policies towards Turkey have always been inspired by the historical mission of the Crusaders

The EU's reforms demanded from Turkey are no different from the terms of the Sevres Treaty of 1920 that marked the defeat of the Ottoman Empire in





**Average Self-Evaluation between 1-10** 







## "Would Turkey's EU membership bring benefits to you personally?"







### Major Cultural Determinants of Euro-supportiveness in 2003 and 2012

- Higher positive economic expectations from the EU (2003&2012)
- Higher degrees of familiarity with Europe (visits to the EU countries, friendship with people from Europe, knowledge about the EU) (2003&2012)
- Lower degrees of feelings of Sevres syndrome (at the level of historical and contemporary fears of European powers trying to divide and rule Turkey) (2003&2012)
- Lower degrees of feelings of cultural threats from Europe (at the level of daily life, concerning moral values) (2003&2012)
- Higher degrees of feelings of international security of Turkey (2003&2012)
- Higher degrees of sharing a common history with Europe (Only in 2003)
- Lower degrees of feelings of double-standards in the EU policies towards Turkey (Only in 2003)
